INGREDIENTS

Rice Bran, Wheat Middlings, Ground Grain Sorghum, Soybean Oil, Soybean Hulls, Beet Pulp, Flax Meal (Linseed Meal), Calcium Carbonate, Copra Meal (Coconut Meal), Dried Distillers Grain, Flax Oil, Coconut Oil, Lignin Sulfonate, and Artificial Flavors.

FEEDING DIRECTIONS

MFM ELEVATE - ES is not a complete feed. It is to be fed in addition to the daily regular ration. As a fat & energy supplement for horses, feed between 1 to 4 pounds per day in addition to a balanced concentrate and high quality hay. If fed with hay alone or a low-protein concentrate, feed 1 to 2 pounds of MFM Equi-Balance along with the MFM ELEVATE - ES to provide a complete balanced feeding program.

Performance Horses: For heavily exercised horses, feed from 2 to 4 pounds per day in addition to a balanced concentrate feed containing at least 12% crude protein. Plus good quality hay. Adjust amount of MFM ELEVATE - ES according to daily work load and desired body condition. Ideal body condition for working horses should be a body condition score of 5 to 6.

Broodmares and Breeding Stallion: Feed 1 to 4 pounds per day to provide additional energy to lactating mares and stallions during the breeding season to help maintain desired body condition.

Yearlings and Two Year Olds: MFM ELEVATE - ES is an excellent way to provide additional fat and a digestible energy source for improving hair coat and body condition of sale horses or young performance prospects. Feed 1 to 2 pounds per day in addition to a complete balanced ration and good quality hay. The concentrate to be fed should contain at least 14% crude protein with at least 0.6% Lysine. If a lower protein concentrate is to be fed, feed 1 to 2 pounds of MFM Equi-Balance to provide additional protein, vitamins & minerals.

Cattle: MFM Elevate - ES can be fed at 1 to 5 pounds per head per day to provide extra fat and energy to optimize growth and acquire desired body condition. Adjust amounts fed with a complete feed and high quality forage to reach desired body condition and do not exceed 6% fat in the total diet dry matter.
