INGREDIENTS

Monocalcium phosphate, dicalcium phosphate, calcium carbonate, salt, processed grain by-products, molasses products, potassium sulfate, magnesium sulfate, yeast culture, manganese sulfate, zinc sulfate, copper sulfate, sodium selenite, ethylenediamine dihydroiodide, cobalt sulfate, vitamin A acetate, vitamin D3 supplement, vitamin E supplement, red iron oxide and artificial flavoring.

FEEDING DIRECTIONS

Thoroughly mix 500 lbs. of MFM 2:1 CTC Mineral with 1,500 lbs. of non-medicated feed. Feed one pound of this medicated mixture to provide 350 mg chlortetracycline. Cattle should receive 350 mg chlortetracycline per head daily for the stated drug claim.

WARNING: A withdrawal period has not been established for this product in pre-ruminating calves. Do not use in calves to be processed for veal.

CAUTION: Use as directed. Consumption of selenium should not exceed 3 mg per head per day.

WARNING: This product which contains added copper, should not be fed to sheep or species that have a low tolerance to supplemental copper.
