acclimated to the presence of blocks, some repositioning may be necessary to achieve proper consumption. DO NOT PROVIDE STARVED ANIMALS FREE ACCESS TO THIS BLOCK.

Consumption of selenium should not exceed 3 mg per head per day.
WARNING: This product, which contains added copper, should not be fed to sheep or any species that have a low tolerance to supplemental copper.
FEEDING AND MANAGEMENT:

1. Feed one block per 20 head of cattle (timid and smaller animals need their share).
2. Place blocks where animals congregate (loafing, grazing, feeding and watering areas).
3. Feed blocks continuously along with plentiful sources of good quality forage and clean, fresh water.
4. Cattle should consume 1 to 2 pounds per head daily based on a 1,000 -pound animal. Two pounds of this product will supply 3 mg of supplemental selenium.
5. For optimal animal performance,
provide a nutritionally balanced free choice mineral supplement in addition to this block.
